



How to Create a Match or Challenge

Inspire your friends and classmates by creating a matching gift or challenge. Matches and challenges are similar, the key difference is that challenges are milestone-based (e.g. if 100 people make a donation, I will give \$250) and matches are made on a per donor/dollar basis (e.g. I will match up to \$500 on a dollar-for-dollar basis for the next \$500 that is donated). Matches and challenges can be of any dollar amount—the idea is to inspire participation and support from your peers and classmates. You can track the progress of your match and/or challenge by visiting the campaign page.

Matching Donations

1. Enter the amount you would like to match (e.g. up to \$150).
2. Select if you would like to match per donor (I will give an amount per donor) or per dollar (I will give an amount per \$1 donated).
3. Select who you would like to restrict your match to. Most matches are not restricted but you can choose to only apply to fellow members of your class or to a list of friends (perhaps your assignments if you are a current class volunteer).
4. Enter your contact information and affiliation.
5. Enter your payment information.
6. After you've created your match, encourage your friends and classmates to join you in supporting George School.

Challenges

1. Enter how much you would like to give.
2. Choose the milestone (e.g. donors or dollars)
3. Select who you would like to restrict your challenge to. Most challenges are not restricted but you can choose to only apply to fellow members of your class or to a list of friends (perhaps your assignments if you are a current class volunteer).
4. Enter your contact information and affiliation.
5. Enter your payment information.
6. After you've created your challenge, encourage your friends and classmates to join you in supporting George School.
