Who can participate in UTMB Giving Day?

Everyone is welcome to participate.

You do not need to be an alumnus or have a formal connection to UTMB to make a difference. Whether you are a student, faculty member, staff member, patient, community supporter, family member, or simply someone who believes in improving health, we invite you to join us on Giving Day.

What gifts count toward UTMB Giving Day?

All online gifts and pledges made on Tuesday, October 6, 2026, count toward the Giving Day fundraising totals.

In addition, mailed gifts designated for Giving Day and postmarked by October 6, 2026, will be included in the overall fundraising total. You can also call our office at (409) 772-5136 to make a gift over the phone.

Please note that mailed gifts are not eligible for Giving Day matches or challenges. Those opportunities are reserved for gifts made online through the Giving Day website during the event.

What are matches and challenges?

Matches and challenges are special opportunities that can increase the impact of your gift.

Often funded by generous alumni and friends, these initiatives encourage participation and help unlock additional support for programs across UTMB. Depending on the challenge, your gift may be matched dollar-for-dollar or help unlock bonus funding once participation goals are reached.

I'm not sure where to direct my gift. What do you recommend?

If you're unsure where your support is needed most, consider giving to the UTMB 1891 Fund or one of the academic annual funds.

These flexible funds provide resources where they are needed most and help support priorities across education, research, patient care, faculty initiatives, and student programs.

I don't see the fund I'd like to support. What should I do?

If your preferred designation is not listed on the Giving Day website, you can submit a custom designation by following these steps:

1. Select **"Other Giving"** from the Programs menu.
2. Select **"Give Now!"**.
3. Enter your desired fund designation in the text box provided.

Will I receive a receipt for my contribution?

Yes.

Donors who make a gift online will receive an email confirmation from GiveCampus acknowledging their donation. An official tax receipt from UTMB will also be emailed for your records.

Is my contribution tax-deductible?

Yes. Gifts made to UTMB on Giving Day are tax-deductible to the extent permitted by law.

Is there a minimum donation amount?

Yes. The minimum online gift amount is \$10.

Can I make my gift anonymously?

Yes.

During checkout, you will have the option to select **“Please do not display my name”** to hide your name from public donor listings while still making your contribution count toward Giving Day totals.

Can UTMB employees participate through payroll deduction?

Yes.
