



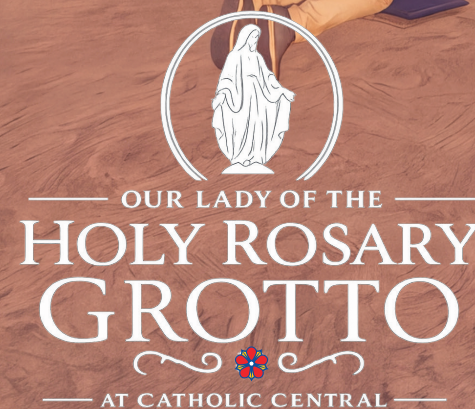
OUR LADY OF THE
